## Why do Catholics do that??

### Why Do Catholic Churches Have a Tabernacle?

The tabernacle is the sacred place where the Blessed Sacrament, the consecrated Body of Christ, is reserved after Mass. Catholics believe that in the Eucharist, Jesus Christ is truly present: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

Because of this REAL presence, the Church keeps the consecrated hosts in the tabernacle for Holy Communion for the sick, Eucharistic adoration, and Prayer before Christ truly present. This belief comes from Christ's own words: This is my body...." Matthew 26:26

A tabernacle is mandatory in every Catholic Church. Church law requires that it be dignified, secure, and placed in a suitable location for prayer. A red sanctuary candle is always burning near the tabernacle when the Eucharist is present.

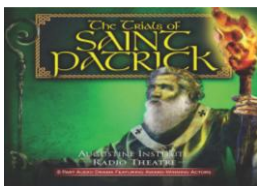
