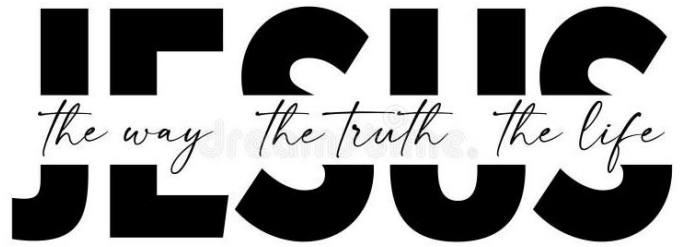

What are the (4) Marks of the Catholic Church?

The first mark of the Catholic Church is **ONE**. The church is one because Christ founded only one Church. We are one in faith, one in baptism, and one with the Lord.

The second mark is **HOLY**. The Church is holy because Christ is holy and He is its head. Though its members are sinners, the Church itself is sanctified by God and filled with His grace.

The third mark is **CATHOLIC**. "Catholic" means universal. The Church is for all people, in all places, and at all times. It proclaims the fullness of the faith to the whole world.

The final mark is **APOSTOLIC**. The Church is apostolic because it is founded on the apostles and continues their mission through apostolic succession— the unbroken line of bishops from the apostles to today.

- May 14: Last Day of School – Classes dismiss at 12:15

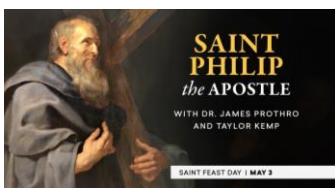
