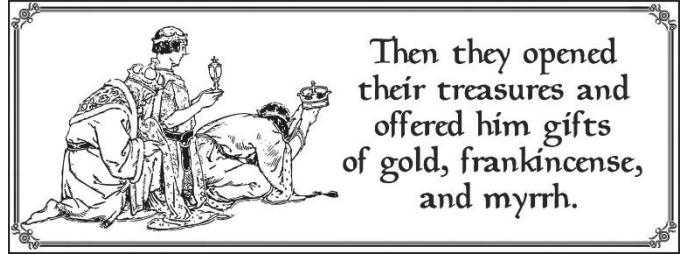

Why do Catholics do that??

What is an Epiphany Blessing?

The Epiphany household blessing or "Chalking the Door" is an old tradition that invokes God's blessing on all who enter one's home, and is usually performed on or near the feast of the Epiphany.

All you need for an Epiphany blessing is chalk. There are a few blessings out there, but the essence of the ritual is always the same: a priest or the head of the household calls down God's blessing on the house and everyone who comes into it, and an inscription is made above the main entrance door in chalk.

The inscription reads: the first two digits of the year +C+M+B+the last two digits of the year (20+C+M+B+25). The letters CMB come from the traditional names for the three kings: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. It also signifies the Latin phrase, "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" which means, "May Christ bless this dwelling!"

This tradition is a sign and symbol of asking God's blessing upon those who live, work, or visit throughout the coming year. In Exodus, the Israelites marked their doors with blood so that the Lord would pass over their homes; but in this tradition, we mark our doors with chalk as a sign that we have invited God's presence and blessing into our homes.

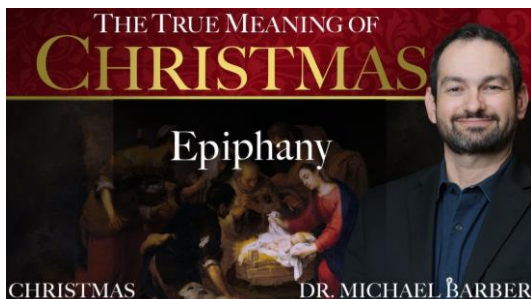
