## Why do Catholics do that??

### Is the Holy Eucharist a symbol?

**The Holy Eucharist Is NOT a Symbol!** Jesus is substantially present—body, blood, soul, and divinity—in Holy Communion. People may misunderstand and believe that the Eucharist is only a symbol of the body and blood of Christ. It is much more than that. Catholics often refer to this as the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Think of the Real Presence as the core of what the Eucharist is: in other words, its “substance.”

In offering the Sacrament of the Eucharist, the substance of bread and wine change into the body and blood of Christ, while the taste, appearance, etc. remain unchanged. The transformed bread and wine are **truly** the Body and Blood of Christ and are not merely symbols. When Christ said “This is my body” and “This is my blood,” the bread and wine are transubstantiated. Though the bread and wine appear the same to our human faculties, they are actually the real body and blood of Jesus.

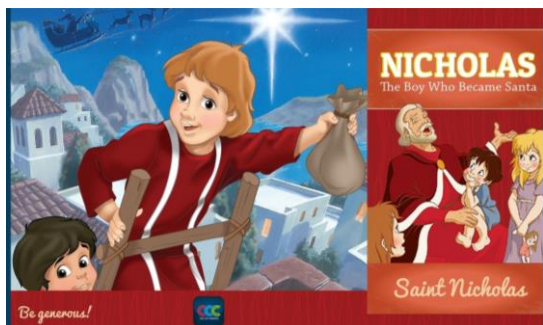
The knights will be having chili before the next meeting on December 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7pm!
