## Why do Catholics do that??

### What happens during The Sacrament of Confirmation?

Confirmation usually takes place during a Mass that is given by the bishop.

The sacrament of confirmation can be divided into four parts:

1. Presentation of the candidate - The individuals awaiting confirmation are called by name.
2. Renewal of baptismal vows - The individuals renew the promises made at their baptism.
3. Laying on of hands - The candidate being confirmed stands/kneels before the bishop, who calls them by their confirmation saint name. A sponsor places their right hand on the candidate's shoulder and the bishop lays his hands on their head and prays that the Holy Spirit will fill them with spiritual gifts.
4. Anointing with chrism - The bishop anoints the candidate with chrism, (holy oil) and makes a sign of the cross on the candidate's forehead, saying the words "be sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit". The bishop then says "peace be with you", which the candidate repeats back to the bishop.
