## Why do Catholics do that??

### Why is Lent 40 days long?

The season of Lent lasts from Ash Wednesday until the evening of Holy Thursday. If Sundays are excluded from the count, the season lasts forty days.

The 40 day length of Lent is rooted in the biblical usage of the number 40. Forty is typically indicative of a time of testing, trial, penance, purification, and renewal. In the New Testament, 40 days is the length of Jesus' time of trial in the desert in preparation for his public ministry. In the Old Testament we hear of Noah's 40 day flood, Moses's 40 years in the desert, Moses fasting for 40 days on Mt. Sinai before receiving the Ten Commandments, the Israelites 40 years of wandering in the desert, the prophet Elijah's 40 days in the desert before encountering God on Mt. Horeb, and the Ninevites 40 day warning before God was going to destroy their city.

As Jesus fasted in the desert for 40 days, we, too, are called to forgo something for the same period when observing Lent.

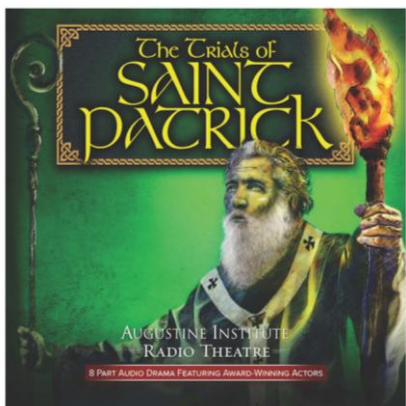
