Why do Catholics do that??

Where do the ashes come from that are used on Ash Wednesday?

Ashes are made from palms used on Palm Sunday.

Per the instructions of the Roman Missal, ashes are typically supposed to be made from last year's Palm Sunday palm branches.

These branches are then burned down into a fine powder and, in the United States, are mixed with holy water or chrism oil to create a light paste.

Anyone can receive this sacramental, even non-Catholics.

Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Donations:

An AED is a medical device used that helps to re-establish heart rhythms for those experiencing cardiac arrest. 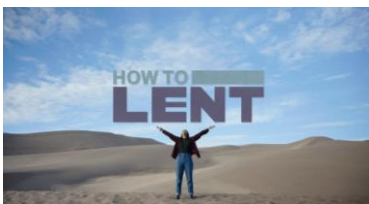
