### Why Stations of the Cross during Lent?

The Stations help the faithful walk with Jesus on His journey to Calvary. They make the Passion tangible, real, and personal. Lent is a season of repentance, reflection, and conversion, and the Stations show us that. They also show us the cost of sin, the depth of Christ's love, the power of obedience and sacrifice, and the mercy available to those who repent.

By meditating on each station, we learn to identify with Jesus' suffering, and in doing so, we are reminded to examine our own lives to see where we deny Him, where we carry our own crosses, and where we fail to love.

The Stations of the Cross are not just a prayer, they are a guide for hearts seeking conversion and deeper union with Christ.
