## Why do Catholics do that??

### **What is the Rice Bowl and where does my money go?**

This is the 50th anniversary of the Rice Bowl Program! The Rice Bowl is the official program of The Catholic Relief Service (CRS), the international humanitarian agency of the Catholic community in the USA. CRS assists poor and suffering people in more than 120 countries on the basis of need, not creed, race or nationality.

The Rice Bowl Program began in 1975 to support world hunger during the drought in the Sahel region of Africa. It was quickly adopted by the Bishops in the US and has spread to nearly 12,000 Catholic parishes and schools.

The Lenten alms collected from the Rice Bowl program are used by the CRS to combat world hunger. 75% of the money that is collected in our parish is sent to the CRS. **25% is donated to the Coordinated Welfare of Marceline to help with things like our local food pantry, local fire victim needs, utility bill help, and Holiday food baskets.**
