Bishop vs ArchBishop

This week, Bishop Sean McKnight, was named as Archbishop of Kansas City, KS. So what is an archbishop? An archbishop is the head of a diocese that is considered to be particularly bigger and more important for some reason. In sacred matters, an archbishop is the equivalent of a bishop, but "archbishop" is considered to be a more prestigious title.

A hierarchy system has been set in place within the Church to help define roles and duties. This safeguards against human fallibility by providing checks and balances for all ranks and positions within the Church. The highest-ranking position within the Church is the Pope while the lowest ranking is a Deacon. Other titles (in order of hierarchy) include: Priest, Monsignor, Vicar General, Bishop, Archbishop, Cardinal, Pope. Please pray for all of our ordained men who help lead the global Church!
