## Why do Catholics do that??

### What is the Divine Mercy Chaplet?

The Divine Mercy Chaplet is a devotion (set of prayers) that is prayed using regular rosary beads. It is a devotion that implores the Father's mercy by invoking the merits Jesus has won for us through his redemptive sacrifice of Calvary. The prayers in the Chaplet come from the Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who received private revelations from Jesus in the 1930's. The chaplet can be prayed at any time of the day, but is traditionally prayed at 3:00pm in many churches around the world. 3:00pm is significant because it's believed to be the hour when Jesus died upon the Cross, signifying the moment of his atonement death on our behalf.
