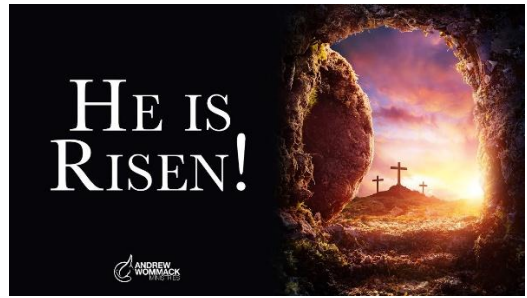

Why do Catholics do that??

What is the Chrism Mass?

On Tuesday of this past week, our diocese celebrated the annual Chrism Mass.

The word *Christ* means *Anointed One*. Many of the most significant moments in the life of a Catholic are marked by a special anointing. For instance, the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Orders and Anointing of the Sick all use sacred oil to symbolize our union with Jesus and the outpouring of his grace. All of that oil is set apart, blessed and distributed at the Chrism Mass.

The Chrism Mass is usually celebrated during Holy Week. During the Chrism Mass, the Oil of the Sick (used for the Anointing of the Sick), the Oil of Catechumens (used for Baptism), and the Chrism Oil are consecrated by the Bishop. Large vessels of oils are carried to the altar for the blessings and consecration of Chrism, which is a mixture of oil and balsam. After Mass the oils are distributed to representatives of each parish. The oils are taken back to the parishes and used for the Sacraments throughout the year.

Another important part of the Chrism Mass is that every priest within the diocese renews his priestly promise.
