Why do Catholics do that??

Do you know how to receive Holy Communion?

When Our Lady appeared to Adele Brise at the Shrine of Our Lady of Champion in Wisconsin, her message was simple, clear and direct. "Teach the children what they need to know for their salvation... Teach them their Catechism, how to sign themselves with the Sign of the Cross, and how to approach the Sacraments;..."

You should be a practicing Catholic, in the state of grace, having kept the one hour fast from food and beverage before Holy Communion. In the USA, the faithful are free to receive Holy Communion standing or kneeling on the tongue or in the hand.

But we should try to receive Our Lord with piety, devotion, hunger, and desire. You get out of it what you put into it.

Divine Mercy Daily:

Every weekday, Monday – Friday, at 3pm, the Divine Mercy Chaplet is being recited at St. Bonaventure Church. Please join us in 15 minutes of prayer! Our Lord has promised to "grant every possible grace to souls" and that you "will receive great mercy at the hour of death". If you cannot be physically present, please join spiritually in this Divine Mercy devotion!
