## Why do Catholics do that??

### Why Do We Share the Sign of Peace at Mass?

The Sign of Peace is a moment in the Mass when we express communion, unity, and reconciliation with one another before receiving The Eucharist. This gesture is rooted in the words of Christ when He teaches that before offering your gift at the altar, you should first be reconciled with your brother.

The Sign of Peace happens right before communion for a reason. It invites us to examine our hearts and let go of anger, bitterness, or division. We cannot receive the Prince of Peace while holding onto division with our peers. The Sign of Peace also reminds us that we are not alone in worship. We are part of one Body, the Body of Christ.

When you share The Sign of Peace at Mass, don't see it as just a routine. See it as preparation; a quiet decision to let go of division and to come to the altar with a heart ready for Christ.
