Why do Catholics do that??

Why Catholics Venerate the Crucifix Rather Than an Empty Cross

The crucifix is an incredible reminder of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection, which are all central aspects of the Catholic faith. But have you noticed that the crucifix is not the universal symbol of Christianity? A simple cross is.

Among the many differences between Catholics and Protestants is the use of a crucifix or cross. The crucifix includes the crucified Christ, whereas a plain cross is empty.

The presence of a crucifix remains a notable distinction between a Catholic parish and a Christian worship space or chapel. Catholics are fully aware and solemnly confess every Sunday in the Creed that Jesus is risen from the dead and sits in glory at the Father's right hand. The crucifix is a depiction of the event of the Passion of our Savior, Jesus, a once, for all and perfect sacrifice (cf. Heb 10:14) that reaches across time but is accomplished.

"The use of a crucifix is mandated in the Catholic liturgy and of both the processional and altar crucifixes. This is because Holy Mass makes present the crucifixion of Jesus"
