What is the Feast of the Ascension of Jesus?

The Feast of the Ascension of Jesus, celebrated forty days after Easter, commemorates the moment when the risen Christ, in the sight of his apostles, ascended bodily into heaven. It marks the completion of his earthly mission and the beginning of his exaltation at the right hand of the Father, where he intercedes for us as our eternal High Priest. The Ascension is a reminder that heaven is our true home and that Jesus, fully God and fully man, has gone before us to prepare a place for us in the Father's house.

In 2026, the Catholic Church will celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of Jesus on Thursday, May 14, 2026. In some dioceses, especially in the United States, the solemnity may be transferred to the following Sunday (May 17) to allow for broader participation among the faithful. This feast is a holy day of obligation, meaning that, unless legitimately excused or otherwise dispensed, Catholics need to participate in Mass to commemorate how Jesus ascended into heaven, completing his earthly mission.
