Why do Catholics do that??

Should Catholics receive both the Holy Eucharist in both body and the blood when both are offered?

Catholics do NOT have to consume both Jesus' body and blood to receive Jesus fully. Each species, by itself, contains Jesus' body, blood, soul, and divinity, thanks to the miracle of transubstantiation that occurs during Mass. So, whether you receive just the host or just the blood, you are wholly receiving Jesus.

The only time you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion is if you are in a state of mortal sin. Otherwise, the Eucharist is meant to be a means of grace and a profound connection with Christ.
