What is the Holy Eucharist?

The Holy Eucharist is a sacrament and sacrifice. The eucharist under appearance of bread and wine is the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Christ. Instituted at the Last Supper, Christ is truly and substantially present in the eucharist. This was held true by all Christians with a few minor exceptions until the Protestant Revolution in the 16th century. Eucharist means "Thanksgiving" the bodily sacrifice celebrated at every Mass. "This is my body", "This is my blood" are clearly Christ giving of himself for all generations. Approaching to receive in a state of sin is a sacrilege further separating one's self from God's grace.
