What is the Feast of Corpus Christi?

The Feast of Corpus Christi this year falls on the weekend of June 6-7. It celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. It is a day of public thanksgiving honoring the core Catholic doctrine that the bread and wine truly become the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ.

Corpus Christi is set aside exclusively to rejoice in and adore the Eucharistic mystery. Many churches hold public Eucharistic Processions accompanied by hymns, prayers, and incense to publicly display and share the Catholic faith.
