### Volunteers/Nominations Needed: Pastoral Council

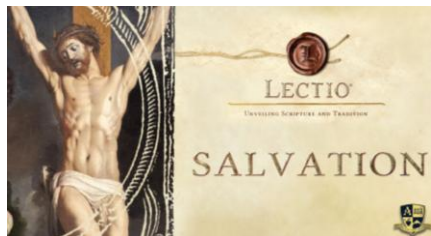

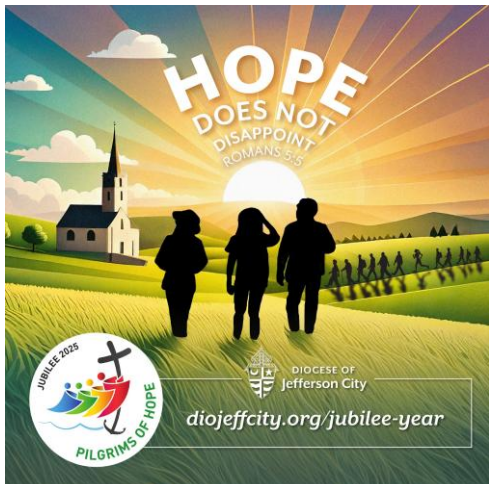
