## Why do Catholics do that??

### **Why do we set aside the month of May for Mary?**

The tradition of dedicating the month of May to Mary, came about in the 13<sup>th</sup> century. Some may say because it was created to replace various pagan cults. The actual reason is the fact that this month is the time when spring is at the height of its beauty. Spring is also connected with nature renewing itself. In her way, Mary gave new life to the world when she gave birth to our savior, Jesus Christ. Although it wasn't always held during May, Mary Month included thirty daily spiritual exercises honoring Mary. It was in this era that Mary's Month and May were combined, making May the Month of Mary with special devotions organized one each day throughout the month. This custom became especially widespread during the nineteenth century and remains in practice until today.

The month of May is a special time for Catholics to pay homage to our Blessed Mother Mary. We pay homage to her. Contrary to misconceptions, we do not worship her. As Catholics, we honor Mary and ask her intercession for us with her son, Jesus.
