## Why do Catholics do that??

### What is Corpus Christi and Eucharistic Procession?

Corpus Christi is the Latin term for Body of Christ. We celebrate Corpus Christi on the Second Sunday after Pentecost. This is a day set aside to call Catholics to express love of the Eucharist to the world, to "proclaim on the housetops" (Mt 10:27) what the apostles came to know at the Last Supper.

Eucharistic processions are often used to celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi. During a procession, the Eucharist is exposed for adoration in a sacred vessel called a Monstrance and carried by the priest. The faithful follow behind usually praying or singing, all in honor of our Eucharistic King. Processions can go around the inside or outside of the church, for blocks, or even miles!

This practice began in the 14<sup>th</sup> century, and has been promoted by popes, councils, and saints as a way to show the supreme importance of the Eucharist and the love we have for Jesus.

### The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will be traveling through our diocese from July 1-5<sup>th</sup>, stopping in Sedalia, Boonville, Jefferson City, Columbia, and Starkeburg. 


Events may include prayers, talks/testimonies, Solemn processions with The Eucharist for adoration, and dinners!
