Why do Catholics do that??

When is the End of Mass?

By Canon Law, The Mass finishes with the Concluding Rites, which may include announcements and always includes the Priest's Greeting and Blessing, the Dismissal, and, finally, "the kissing of the altar by the Priest and the Deacon, followed by a profound bow to the altar by the Priest, the Deacon, and the other ministers," (*GIRM*, 90d). The Mass ends when the priest pronounces it and we receive the final blessing and are sent forth by the deacon or priest. We should not make it a habit to leave after Holy Communion.

We should attend Mass not simply as a "me and God" experience but as a member of a community, as a part of something larger than *myself*. Leaving early without a serious reason focuses our attention on our own personal desires rather than committing ourselves to the Mass and our brothers and sisters in Christ.


