How did Roman Collars Become the Priestly Uniform?


Priests wore cassocks and various collars until in 1624 the church concluded that the time had come for stricter guidelines for clerical garb because collars had grown into a major fashion statement. The fancier the collar, the wealthier the owner did not stay true to the church's teachings. The Church teaches that a priest is Christ's representative on Earth, and since a priest is consecrated to God, he should embrace material poverty as did our Lord. So, in 1624, Pope Urban VIII forbade ornamentation or lace, and the Church regulated the fashionable collars to simple ones. Today, we are familiar with the most common form of this simple collar: the "Roman Collar", with its simple white square.
