Why do Catholics do that??

Who was St. Bonaventure?

Our church's patron, St. Bonaventure was born in Italy in 1221 and named through an intercession to St. Francis of Assisi. His feast day is July 15. He entered the Franciscan order and studied with St. Thomas Aquinas. He worked to restore calm and order for the Franciscans and later wrote and translated many works.

St. Bonaventure is a Doctor of the church. He was a great philosopher and theologian, but understood that those studies should not oppose the call of poverty that was central to the Franciscan spirituality, something that was rampant in the time of his life.

In 1273, he was appointed by Pope Gregory X as Cardinal and Bishop. He is remembered for his great works of literature, art, philosophy and theology that were inspired by the Christian faith during the time period he lived. Pope Benedict is known to have called the faithful to take note of "the central role that Christ always played in Bonaventure's life and teaching," and to imitate the way in which "the whole of his thinking was profoundly Christocentric."

St. Bonaventure died on July 15, 1274 and was canonized a saint in 1482.
