Bishop McKnight recently posted this on his social media account: "Being an altar server allows young parishioners to become more active in their faith and can be an early step toward a religious vocation. Talk to your children about this honored role and give them time to reflect on it. Thank you to the youth of our diocese who are already serving Christ as an altar server. Know that your service and commitment are inspiring to all!"

Often it takes a lot of encouragement and commitment from the parents for a child to serve. Children who have received their First Holy Communion are eligible to serve at Mass when they have been trained properly. If you are interested in having your child serve, please contact Fr. Paschal. He would be excited to work with your child to teach them how to serve!
