## Why do Catholics do that??

### What Bible should I use if I am Catholic?

The Holy Bible is the world's most well-known book. As Catholics, it is important in our Liturgy of the Word. The most noticeable differences between a Catholic and Protestant Bible occur in the number of books included in the Old Testament and the order in which they have been arranged. A Protestant Old Testament contains 39 books, whereas a Catholic OT contains 46 books. The New Testament is the same in all Bibles.

Here's a list of the most recently approved translations:

- New American Bible: Revised Edition – 2011 (Most widely used in the US and is used for Mass Readings)
- Ignatius Bible – 2006
- Good News Bible: Catholic Edition – 1992
- New Jerusalem Bible – 1990
- New Revised Standard Version – Catholic Ed. – 1989
