## Why do Catholics do that??

### **Why do Catholics stand, sit, and kneel during Mass?**

The first part of the Mass, the Liturgy of the Word, consists of prayers, reading and preaching. We stand out of respect for the Gospel because the Gospel is the words of Jesus. We sit for the other readings and for the homily.

The second part of the Mass, the Liturgy of the Eucharist, consists of a sacrifice, and there are times-especially in this part when the faithful pray on their knees. Kneeling shows our humility before God and our small sacrifice to participate in the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Many places in scripture refer to kneeling. Ephesians 3:14 Paul says, "I kneel before the Father," and in Acts 9:40 Peter "knelt down and prayed." The Catholic habit of kneeling is consistent with Scripture and is another manifestation of the continuity between the Church of the first century and the Catholic Church today.
