Why Should Catholics Baptize Their Babies?

Having your baby baptized in the Catholic Church is not optional for Catholic parents. It is essential to baptize your baby to remove original sin from his/her soul, restore him/her to God's friendship, allow God to dwell in him/her, restore sanctifying grace in the soul, and make Heaven possible.

The Church requires parents to have their child baptized. The Baltimore Catechism teaches: "It is wrong to defer the baptism of an infant, because we thereby expose the child to the danger of dying without the Sacrament." And, the 1917 Code of Canon Law stated, "Infants should be baptized as soon as possible; pastors and preachers should frequently stress with the faithful the gravity of their obligation" (Cn 770).
