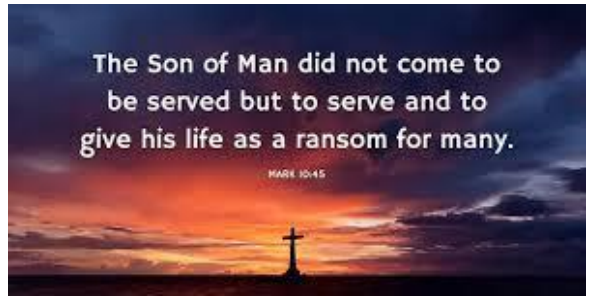

Why do Catholics do that??

When should I receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation?

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states, "after having attained the age of discretion (usually considered after age 7), each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year" (CCC 1457)

"Serious sins" in the *Catechism* are to be understood as mortal sins. Keep in mind that for a sin to be mortal, three conditions must be met: grave matter, full knowledge, and complete consent (CCC 1857).

Catholics should also be in a "state of grace," meaning to be free from mortal sin, before receiving communion. As the *Catechism* states, "Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance" (CCC 1415).
