Why do Catholics use incense during Mass?

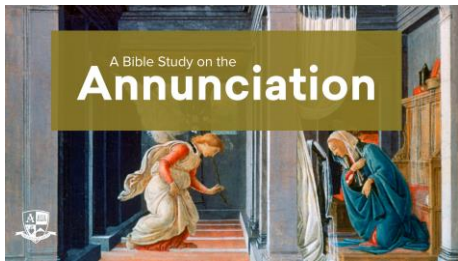
The use of incense in religious rites dates back to the time of Moses (Ex. 3:1-10). The earliest known Christian usage is during the fifth century.
